Course Description: This course focuses on six critical areas: (1) extend understanding of *numerical manipulation* to *algebraic manipulation*; (2) synthesize understanding of *functions*; (3) deepen and extend understanding of *linear relationships*; (4) apply *linear models* to data that exhibit a *linear trend*; (5) establish criteria for *congruence based on rigid motions*; and (6) apply the *Pythagorean Theorem* to the coordinate plane.

Class Goal: Our class will average a 2.7 or higher on all assessments.

Classroom Expectations: Always be READY.

Class Incentives: Students will receive merits when they show exceptional learning behaviors.

Academic Dishonesty

Quizzes/Tests

Quizzes occur every week on Monday unless there is a test that week. Test dates will be given in advance and preparation will be through classwork and homework. If student is absent the day of a test or quiz it is his/her responsibility to make arrangements to take the test/quiz missed on his/her own time.

Late/ Missing Work policy

Late or missing work must be turned in by the next class date. Student must attach a pink slip (w/ parent signature) to their late homework before turning it in. Students can only turn in late work from the previous week on Mondays. This excludes classwork.

Absent Work

It is important that you come to class everyday. However, in the case an absence occurs the following is the procedure for makeup work:

2. Email teacher for further instructions or clarifying questions.
3. Turn in work (with note on top stating you were absent) into turn in bin upon return.

Reassessment Policy

Students can retake any formative assignment one time. The prerequisites for any reassessment are homework completion, an error analysis (quiz correction) and one tutoring session. In addition, student must have turned in the assignment on original due date. The reassessment must be completed prior to a summative assessment.
